



# Rosé 2018



High Altitude Terroir – Fenouillèdes region  
Villages of Saint Martin de Fenouillet, Le Vivier, Lesquerde,  
Saint Arnac and Felluns

Soils of decomposed granites and gneiss (99 %) and Albian black marls (1 %)  
between 350 m and 600 m high

86 % Syrah (25 year old vineyards on average)  
14 % Carignan (80 year old vineyards on average)

Yield : 18 hl/ha  
Production : 17 000 bottles – 100 magnums  
Alcohol : 12,62 % ; pH : 3.48; Total acidity : 3.47 gH<sub>2</sub>SO<sub>4</sub>/l

Biodynamic viticulture with ploughing  
Single spur pruning (guyot) and bush vines (gobelet)  
Use of biodynamic preparations and plant infusions  
Hand harvested

Whole bunch maceration for 3 to 15 days  
Natural yeasts

Blend of different vintages :  
2017 (55 %) 2016 (37 %) 2015 (8 %)

55 % in 500-litre neutral oak barrels  
33 % in tank  
12 % oak tanks

No fining  
Clarifying filtration before bottling



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
